PARENTS' EVENING: On Tuesday 16th April and Wednesday 17th April you will have the opportunity to talk to your child's teacher about their progress and attainment. Also you will be able to look at your child's books.

SATS WEEK: Year 6 SATS week commences Monday 13th May and ends on Thursday 16th May. Year 2 will complete their optional SATS tests this half term too. The children are working hard to prepare. **PHONIC SCREENING:** for Year 1 will take place the week beginning 10th June. The children are working hard and any reading that they can do at home will help too.

TIMES TABLES TEST: for Year 4 will take place the week beginning 10th June. Again the children are working hard and any Times Tables Rockstars or other practice that they can do at home will help too.

ASSESSMENTS: All other classes are completing their class assessments this term.

You will be made aware of your child's progress and attainment in their end of year reports which will go out in July. Results from SATS and other national tests will also be on the reports.

YEAR 6 LEAVERS: The key dates for the events around the Year 6 leavers are in the diary section at the end of the newsletter.

YEAR 6 LEAVERS' HOODIES: Information will be sent home about Leavers' hoodies this half term.

SCHOOL TRIPS: We are currently planning class trips in Summer 2024. More information will be shared by the class teacher. Once again, we are aware of the current financial restraints and we will again be supporting each class with a donation of £200.00 per trip from the School's Voluntary Fund which is in place to support enrichment throughout the school. This donation will make a direct impact on the cost of the trip and will reduce the contribution for all children.

CLASS ASSEMBLIES: Our class assemblies will continue in the summer term with the classes who have not yet done their class assembly. CLASS MASSES: Father Philip regularly comes to school to celebrate Mass on Thursday at 10.00am. The classes in KS 2 attend on a rota. All are welcome. Please see the Parish newsletter or ask staff if there is a Mass on a particular week.

PARENTS' MEETING for new Reception and Nursery children: On Wednesday July 3rd at 6.00pm we are inviting parents and carers who have children starting in Nursery or Reception in September 2024 to a meeting. The purpose of this is to provide the opportunity for parents to meet the staff, share information and ask questions and to look around the setting. The children can also attend this meeting.

The **Reception** children who are starting in September 2024 will then attend from 9.00am on the morning of **Thursday**, **July 4**th and will stay for lunch at school and be collected at 1.15pm. If your child is in nursery and stays in the afternoon then they will stay as normal for the afternoon session. Further details will be sent in a letter to parents. We are looking forward to welcoming everyone into school.

SWIMMING LESSONS: Year 3 and Year 4 begin their swimming lessons each Tuesday afternoon during Summer Term 1 and Year 5 and Year 6 will begin swimming lessons in Summer Term 2 after the half term break. This is an important life skill for our pupils.

UNIFORM: The children have returned to school looking very smart, thank you for your support with this. During summer term the uniform is;

Summer Uniform

- Grey skirt/pinafore/trousers or grey shorts
- Dress Gingham Blue
- Blue short-sleeved polo shirt or light blue polo shirt
- Footwear Only sensible, black footwear may be worn. Boots and trainers are not allowed.

We have had lots of uniform donated thank you and there is a rail near the school entrance with uniform on- please help yourself.

Jewellery: is not permitted at any time. (except a watch-not a smartwatch), this covers earrings or retainers and includes those covered by plasters.

Hair: Long hair should be tied up, no extreme hairstyles are allowed, e.g., bleach, tramlines, highlights, spikes etc.
